



Economics Related Coverent Developments. 1) concept of Monetwy 4 fiscal Policy. Monetary Policy: > Policies related to the Money Supply in the Indian Market. → It is Managed by RBI (Reserve Bank of India) RBI is the central Bank of India. RBI is also called as Banker's Bank. - Main Purpose of RBI is to control state of Infilation in Indian Economy. There are tooks used by RBI to control inflation. These tools are called as Monetary Policy. Important concept :-1 When there is more money in the market there is inflationary tendency in the Market. 2) when there is less money in the market there is Deflationary tendency in the Market. 3 whenever there is Inflationary tindency in the Mannet RBI tries to bring down the Inflation. RBI applies contractionary Policies. 1 when Deflationary tendency -> RBI brings the Inflation up. in the market RBI applies Expansionary Policies · In Contractionary Policy money from the market is taken out. · In Expansionary Policy, money is infused into the Market.

Monetary Policy tools :-

- Il Repo Rate :- This is the mate of interest at which RBI gives loan to commercial bank.
- Z Reverse Reposite This is the rate of Interest at which commercial banks give loan to RBI.
- 3) Open Market Operations: (OMO): Purchase and Sales of T-Bills (Treasury Bills) and gout.
 Securities by RBI is called as open market operations.


Tools of fiscal policy Include

 - -> A ministry MOILT was formed under IT Act.

It Act 2000 is one of the most basic law in the field of Information Technology but it only says that electronic documents will also have the same validity in the count of law as the Physical Documents. But it did not talk about Cyber security. Cyber scam (8) any other thing such as Social Media e-commerce etc. Therefore IT Act needs Urgent update.

IT Act Amendments, 2008 :-

Under Section 66(A) of IT Act 2000.
